DAILY SCHEDULE

Saturday, September 19

- 15:00 – Homestay hosts greet you at Place Versailles at your arrival from Quebec City
- 15:30 – Brief stop at the home of your hosts to leave luggage and freshen-up
- 18:30 – Céline Tremblay and René Bourassa host the Welcome Dinner at their home in Longueuil

Sunday, September 20

- 9:30 – Early risers can visit the Kahnawà:ke Indian reserve
- 10:30 – Tom Deer, of the Kahnawà:ke Language and Cultural Centre, provides background info on Iroquois/Mohawk history and culture, then leads a museum visit
- ±13:00 – Lunch at Bistro La Traite, Île Saint-Bernard (AE)
- 14:30-17:30 – Pontoon ride along the Chateauguay River in the company of a naturalist; historical visit through a XVII-XVIIIth Century 'seigneurie'; optional walk through a wildlife refuge (AE); optional apple-picking (AE); etc.
- 17:30 – End of the outing and free evening (AE)

Monday, September 21

- 10:45 – Visit of historical Old-Montreal and the Old-Port of Montreal
- 12:30 or so – Lunch at the Montreal Science Centre (AE)
- 15:45 – End of the visit, with some time to relax before dinner
- 18:30 – Dinner at the home of meal hosts

Tuesday, September 22

- Free day spent with your homestay hosts
- Ambassadors invite homestay hosts to dinner (AE)

Wednesday, September 23

- 10:00-11:00 – Start of a “rally” through underground and above-ground Montreal, using public transit; there are four different departures; areas visited include the financial and business districts, the entertainment centre around Place des Spectacles

and other downtown sights

- 12:30 or so – Lunch at a typical mall food court (AE)
- 15:00-16:00 – End of the rally and free evening (AE)

Thursday, September 24

- Morning – Late brunch at the home of your homestay host
- 12:30 – Visit of some of the city’s highlights: Biodôme, Olympic Park, Montreal Botanical Garden
- 17:30 – Picnic meal
- 18:30 – Visit of the “Gardens of Light” at nightfall
- 19:30-20:00 – End of the activity
